Proposed changes to bylaws and resolutions may be submitted by any member (local association or Friend of Community Living Ontario), as well as the Community Living Ontario Board and Council.

The deadline for submitting proposed resolutions or bylaw amendments for discussion at the upcoming 71st Annual General Meeting is Tuesday, June 25, 2024.

Do not worry about putting your proposed resolution or bylaw amendment into a specific motion. We can assist with the format after you submit your proposed changes. Simply let us know as clearly as possible what you think should be put forward for discussion and consideration. Provide a brief background note as to why you feel this is important.

## Resolutions

You may submit proposed resolutions for discussion and consideration that do one of the following things:

- (a) Give direction or set limits on what means the Board of Directors may or may not use in the pursuit of Association goals.
- (b) Add, amend, or repeal a social policy position being advocated by Community Living Ontario; or
- (c) Recognize the achievements and good work of members or external organizations, groups, or individuals.
